Call for Abstracts

Seoul National University College of Medicine Alumni Association (SNUCMAA) invites medical students and graduates of Seoul National University College of Medicine to submit abstracts for Oral Presentations at the 39th SNUCMAA Convention scheduled on April 12 - 13, 2025 at the Westin Tysons Corner Hotel in Falls Church, VA, USA. Abstracts are due for submission on **Monday, December 16th at 11:59pm (US Eastern Time)**. The nine highest-quality abstracts, as voted on by the Scientific Committee, will be selected for 10-minute oral presentations.

Abstract Submission Guidelines

Abstracts should be no longer than 250 words in length (excluding author information). The title should objectively describe the study. The body of your abstract should describe the background, methods, results, and conclusions of your research. Authors may include a table or figure. Correspondence will be directed to the first author listed on the submission who will also serve as the speaker if selected for oral presentation. If the primary author is unavailable, a co-author can present. Abstract should be emailed to snucmaa2025@gmail.com. The first author (presenting author) will receive an email acknowledging receipt of the abstract and will receive a letter of notification from the Program Committee regarding its decision in January 2025.

Submission Eligibility

Seoul National University College of Medicine alumni who are currently in post-graduate medical training program in the US are encouraged to submit abstracts to the SNUCMAA. Also, Seoul National University College of Medicine medical students or graduates who are planning to pursue residency or fellowship in the US are allowed to submit abstracts. Submissions accepted for publication or presentation elsewhere including journals or conferences within past 12 months may be submitted. One submission per first author is permitted.

Oral Presentations

The first authors of the nine highest quality abstracts will be invited to give a 10-minute, in-person (preferred) or virtual oral presentation on April 13, 2025, at 10:30AM-12:00PM (US Eastern Time).

Travel Awards

First author on the abstract who agrees to present the abstract in person at the meeting will be eligible for reimbursement for registration, transportation expense (economy class domestic airfare, train, local transportation), hotel (up to two nights at the Westin Tysons Corner Hotel), and convention banquet.
